

# 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Information – Class of 2020

There are many events and activities to prepare for this school year. With your school tuition you paid \$200 to cover eighth grade expenses which include:

- **Graduation Gown Photos** Students will take individual photos in a graduation gown during the school day on February 18, 2020. You will be able to purchase picture packages from Barberito Photographers at that time.
- Yearbook Ads You will be able to purchase a yearbook add for your eighth grader if you choose. More information will be sent by the school at a later date. The Eighth Grade Class Coordinators do not handle these ads.

# **Specific Information about the Above Items:**

#### **T-shirts**

The group caricature drawing will be transferred to t-shirts. Each student will receive one (1) t-shirt. Additional shirts may be purchased for \$11/shirt via the attached order form. Students will be allowed to wear these shirts to school on designated days and on the 8<sup>th</sup> grade field trip.

#### DVD

A DVD commemorating their years at MBS will be given to each student. It will include pictures of events throughout their years at MBS.

### **Graduation Breakfast**

The breakfast is for eighth grade students only – no parents. We will need a (4x6) hard copy baby photo of each eighth grader for a special decoration for the breakfast. This picture will be trimmed and attached to artwork and will be returned in such manner after the graduation reception in the St. John room.

#### **Class Poetry Book**

Students will receive a class poetry book at the end of the school year. They will work on the contents during the school year, and a class coordinator will assemble the works into a booklet for the students.
